Course Objectives

Each participant are required to perform competently in the management of given patient situation in following:

1. Respiratory Arrest
2. Automated External Defibrillation (AED)
3. Pulseless Ventricular Tachycardia /Ventricular Fibrillation
4. Asystole
5. Pulseless Electrical Activity
6. Acute Coronary Syndromes
7. Bradycardia & AV Blocks
8. Stable and Unstable Tachycardia
9. Acute Ischemic Stroke



Course is followed by practical assessment of each participant in a given situation and a written examination which must be passed with minimum score of 84% in a closed book having 50 multiple choice question.
