Course Description

Program participants learn to recognize the signs and symptoms of injuries and sudden illness. Crucial information about how to deal with emergencies like bleeding, shock, burns, strains, fractures, allergic reaction, diabetic and seizures are taught. The participant will also learn, how to activate emergency medical system at the time of emergency, how to use Personnel Protective Devices during rescue breathing, to know about Sequence of Survival (SOS), Breathing Difficulties, Cardiac Arrest, Heart Attack, Stroke, CPR (Adult), Relieve of Foreign-body airway obstruction and the use of an AED (automated external defibrillator), Awareness about oxygen administration and Blood borne pathogens and Special Consideration for Resuscitation such as, Drowning, Traumatic injury, Electric Shock, Heat Stroke, Pregnancy, Swine Flu etc with written exam having passing score of 80% having multiple choice questions.

Following successful completion of BFA & CPR Course, participant should be able to quickly assess the scene and victim and provide appropriate care for the victim(s) until professionals arrive.
